General Rules

The International Synchronized Skating Competition will be conducted in accordance with the current ISU General Regulations and Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Synchronized Skating as well as all pertinent ISU Communications (for season 2021-2022), including ISU Communications 2238 and 2236 and the Technical Requirements for ISU Adult Figure Skating Competitions for season 2021-2022. The ISU judging system will be applied. For the Junior and Novice Categories the ISU Communications 2316 and 2380 shall additionally apply, which allow an exception of the upper age limits for the 2021/22 season.

All programs will be judged in accordance with ISU Com. 2236, Com. 2392 and Com. 2238. The Well Balanced Program Content for the categories Pre-Juvenile, Juvenile and Non ISU Basic Novice coincides with the category ISU Basic Novice. The Well Balanced Program for the Adult category coincides with the ISU Adult Figure Skating Competitions for season 2021-2022.

Categories and Technical Rules

Technical requirements:

Pre Juvenile: shall consist of 8-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. At least 75% of the skaters must not have reached the age of 11 before 1st July, 2021. A maximum of 25% must not have reached the age of 13 before 1st July, 2021.

Free skating program 3.00 mi (+ / - 10 sec)

The Program Components Factor is 1,6

Juvenile: shall consist of 8-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. At least 75% of the skaters must not have reached the age of 13 before 1st July, 2021. A maximum of 25% must not have reached the age of 15 before 1st July, 2021.

Free skating program: 3.00 min (+ / - 10 sec)

The Program Components Factor is 1,6

Non ISU shall consist of 8-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. They

Basic Novice: must have reached at least the age of 10 before 1st July 2021 and not have reached the age of 15 before July 1st, 2021.

Free skating program: 3.00 min (+ / - 10 sec)

The Program Components Factor is 1,6

Mixed Age: shall consist of 8-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters, no age limit.

Free skating program: 3.00 min (+ / - 10 sec);

The Program Components Factor is 1,6

Vaults and un-sustained lifts are permitted in the category Mixed Age.

- Adult:** shall consist of 12-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. At least three quarters (75%) of team members (not including reserves) must have reached at least the age of twenty-eight (28) before 1st July 2021. A maximum of one quarter (25%) of the members of a team must have reached at least the age of twenty-one (21) before 1st July 2021.
- Free skating program: 3.00 min (+ / - 10 sec)
Program Components Factor is 1,0
- Junior B:** shall consist of 12-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. All of them must have reached at least the age of 13 before 1st July 2021 but not have reached the age of 19 before July 1st, 2021.
- Free Skating program: 3.30 min (+ / - 10 sec)
Program Components Factor is 1,6
- Senior B:** shall consist of 12-16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. All of them must have reached at least the age of 15 before 1st July 2021.
- Free Skating program: 4 minutes (+ / - 10 sec)
Program Components Factor is 1,6
- Advanced Novice ISU:** shall consist of 16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. They must have reached at least the age of 10 before 1st July 2021 but not have reached the age of 15 before July 1st, 2021.
- Free Skating program: 3.00 min (+ / - 10 sec)
Program Components Factor is 1,6
- Junior ISU:** shall consist of 16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. All of them must have reached at least the age of 13 before 1st July 2021 but not have reached the age of 19 before July 1st, 2021.
- Short Program: 2.50 min (but may be less),
Program Components Factor is 0,8
- Free Skating program: 3.30 min (+ / - 10 sec)
Program Components Factor is 1,6

Senior ISU: shall consist of 16 skaters with a maximum number of 4 (four) alternate skaters. All of them must have reached at least the age of 15 before 1st July 2021.

Short Program: 2.50 min (but may be less)

Program Components Factor is 0,8

Free Skating program: 4.00 min (+ / - 10 sec)

Program Components Factor is 1,6

Entries and Entry Fee

All entries have to be sent to the Organizing Committee (OC) of the Third Cup of Dresden 2022 via email: cup-of-dresden@web.de.

Please use the **Preliminary Entry Form** to indicate your team's participation in the competition. The preliminary entry form has to be submitted no later than **October 10, 2021**. Final entries have to be submitted no later than **November 28th, 2021**. Please, also enclose a team photo.

The **fixed entry fee** for the Second Cup of Dresden will be:

Please note:

1. The entry fee payment does not include extra practice ice nor any offered meals at the competition.
2. Should a team withdraw from the event after that date, the amount will not be returned.
3. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel on short notice this competition, due to the Coronavirus (COVID19) situation, the decisions of the national and/or local Health Authorities, and various international travel/quarantine restrictions. In case of cancellation before December 31, 2021, the OC will refund the participation fee at 100%. In case of cancellation after December 31, 2021, the OC will refund the participation fee at 90%.

PPC

The planned program content must be sent to the OC before November 28th, 2021. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet is filled in precisely by each team in English, using the terminology for the elements listed in the Scale of Value Table published in ISU Com. 2322. The Planned Program Content Sheet has to be signed by the coach or team manager of the participating team.

Music

All teams have to provide their competition music of excellent quality as an MP3-File via email before November 28th, 2021. Please send the music as MP3-file to: cup-of-dresden@web.de. The respective email should only contain one music file or file link. The subject of the email must be clearly identified and should be labeled in the format "*category, team name and exact duration of the program*". Additionally, each team shall bring along a labeled CD or USB-Stick with the music of the Free Program and Short Program.

Registration

The registration for Referees, Judges, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists, Data/Replay Operators, Teams, Accredited Coaches, Team Leaders and Team Managers will take place at the designated registration office in the "EnergieVerbund Arena" on February 26, 2022 starting at 7 a.m. All registered skaters have to submit a copy of their passport or ID card (EU citizens only) when they sign in.

Please note: For admission to the ice rink and all facilities belonging to the sports complex a negative PCR test no older than 48 hours, proof of vaccination or recovery from a Covid19 infection is required. Further instructions on this subject will follow and will be updated in accordance with the current hygiene measures of the Free State of Saxony and Germany.

Draw

The starting order for the competition will be drawn electronically after the conclusion of the Unofficial Extra Practice on Friday, 25 February 2022. The result of the draw will be published prior to the competition on our website no later than 19.00 pm on Friday, February 25, 2022. www.cup-of-dresden.de

Official Practice and Unofficial Extra Practice Ice

The Official Practice will start on Saturday, February 26, 2022 approximately around 7.30 a.m. (the schedule is subjected to change!). Each Interclub team will be allowed a 10 (ten) minute period of official practice ice, which is already included in the entry fee. Junior and Senior teams will be allowed a 10 (ten) minute period for their short program.

Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior teams will be allowed a 12 (twelve) minute period of official practice ice for their free skating. The official practice is already included in the entry fee. No other music but the short program and free program music will be played during the official practice segments.

Once the music has started it will be played through in its entirety with no interruption. The music will be played twice during each official practice session.

If you require **extra practice ice**, please make your reservation no later than November 28th, 2021. We kindly ask you to send your preferred time slots to the OC via email: cup-of-dresden@web.de. Depending on the demand we reserve the right to arrange the time slots for each team accordingly.

Extra practice ice will be available on Thursday 24 and Friday, February 25, 2022. The detailed time slots will be announced in due time.

The organizer will charge 40€ per 15 minutes on the ice. The confirmation of the fixed time slot for the extra practice session and the invoice with the date of payment will be sent to you via email.

Awards

A trophy will be presented to the winning team in each category. Further, the three best-placed teams will be awarded medals. All participants will receive a certificate of participation.

Transportation and Ice Rink

Teams arriving by bus may use the designated pick-up/drop-off area in front of the EnergieVerbund Arena (Dresden, Magdeburger Str. 10). Busses cannot park there, but may use one of the parking places in close proximity to the ice rink. If you need any help in finding a suitable parking spot or means of transportation, please contact the OC.

The transportation is granted to the Technical Panel, Referees and Judges.

The ice rink "EnergieVerbund Arena" is located at Magdeburger Straße 10, not far from the city center of Dresden. Easy to be reached: 20 minutes by car from Dresden International Airport, 10 minutes by car from the main railroad station.

The "EnergieVerbund Arena" consists i.a. of three ice rinks, a three fields sports hall and a ballet room. The competition will be held at the main ice rink called "Arena". The "Arena" has a capacity of 3099 seats and total capacity of 4.412 people. The ice surface has a size of 30m x 60m. The spectator and team area will be heated during the competition.

Meals

During the competition the restaurant "Auszeit", located within the EnergieVerbund Arena, will provide a buffet for the teams upon request. An extra fee will be charged per meal and per team member.

Please, notify the OC until January 14, 2022 if you wish to book lunch and/or dinner at the restaurant.

Judges Meeting

The Judges Meeting will be held on Friday, February 25, 2022 at 6.00 pm at the official team hotel (HN Collection).

Medical Information

Each team manager should be able to give important medical information for each skater for use in case of an emergency or accident. Such information should include but is not limited to the following, and will greatly help local medical and emergency personnel: allergies, existing medical conditions (i.e. asthma), current medications, immunizations, blood type, use of glasses, contact lenses, dental appliances.

Liability

In accordance with ISU Rule 119, the Dresdner Eislauf-Club e.V. (organizer) accepts no liability for injury or damage sustained by competitors or officials. The organizer will not provide participant insurance coverage for the event. Each club or team is expected to provide its own insurance protection. The organizer will provide emergency medical services for all participants during the competition and official practice.
